The Playcentre is registered for 70 children and provides full and part-time day care service for children, between the ages of 3 months to 5 years of age. The Playcentre is registered with the Care Standards Inspectorate for Wales and is also a registered educational provider for 3-5 year old children.

The Holiday Playcare Scheme is held at the Playcentre and provides quality full and part-time holiday care for children aged 3-12 years, with a fun filled itinerary. Spaces are limited therefore please contact the Childcare Services Manager for further details.

Mission Statement

We strive to provide a service that is of the highest standard, encouraging a positive family approach to health, well-being and education.

Aims

We employ caring qualified nursery nurses who aim to ensure that every child's happiness and well-being is at the heart of everything we achieve. Using the Birth to Three framework and the Foundation Phase curriculum a range of activities are incorporated into our daily routine. We aim to help all children achieve their full potential by providing a sustainable environment, which is rich in indoor and outdoor learning opportunities.

Facilities at the Playcentre

The Playcentre is situated on campus in a quiet location which is surrounded by trees and shrubs. We have very safe play areas with soft ground cover and secure fencing and covered areas for shade and shelter. There is a CCTV security system, an alarm system and stringent intercom security procedures in operation throughout the nursery building. The nursery is divided into:

Activity Room – A large room offering opportunities for the varied age range of children cared for at the Playcentre throughout each day.

Snuggly Bugs Room – Caters for nine babies from 3-18 months.

Busy Bees Room – Caters for twelve children from 1-2 years of age.

Little Explorers Room – Caters for twelve children from 2-3 years of age.

Pre-school Room – Caters for twenty children from 2.5-5 years of age.

Outside Area/Forest Area – Provides a range of opportunities for the children's physical needs and all round development.

- The meal package is included within the fees. For health and safety reasons, no home cooked foods can be reheated at the Playcentre.
- The minimum booking will be no less than 2 days per week.
- Students must contract during term time and pay the equivalent of one week's full fees on entry each academic year as a holiday retainer.
- Staff will not be charged for Bank Holidays and the closure at Christmas, you will contract for all other days.
- All nappies, wipes and creams must be provided for individual children.
- There will be a £1.00 charge per child per week during term time to cover additional activities such as parties, dance and music session.
